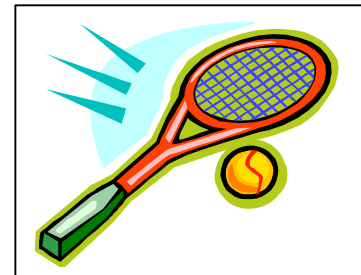

## Conditions of play

The tournament is sanctioned by the Lawn Tennis Association and will be conducted under the present rules of Lawn Tennis and the Rules and Regulations of the LTA including the Code of Conduct.

Only those competitors who have, or will have, reached the minimum age for the event on or before the 31 December 2010 are eligible to compete.

The amount of prize money to be awarded for each event will be determined by the Committee once the entries have been received.

If necessary, the Committee reserves the right to merge events or to arrange qualifying rounds to be played prior to the commencement of the tournament.

No competitor may enter more than two events, one singles and one doubles. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving a reason.

The draw for all events will be made on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> January at the Tennis Club.

**Entries must be received by first post on Thursday 31<sup>st</sup> December 2009 to West Bridgford Tennis Club, Little Bounds, Off Wilford Lane, West Bridgford, Nottingham NG2 7QA accompanied by the appropriate entry fees.**

All competitors must sign in and report to the Referee immediately on arrival and be prepared to play when called. Any competitor who does not report when called will be considered absent and liable to be disqualified. Before leaving the premises all competitors must check with the Referee to determine the time of their next match.

Matches will be the best of three sets, tie break at 6-6 in the first two sets and a 10 point match tie break as the third set. The Committee reserves the right to abbreviate matches if required.

It is anticipated that play will be from 1:00 pm on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> January and at 10:00 am on Friday, Saturday and Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> January.

Play will be on 3 indoor cushioned acrylic courts.

An ITF approved tennis ball will be used.

Competitors must wear recognised tennis clothing and shoes.

Competitors should take all necessary precautions to minimise his/her own risk and is solely responsible for any loss, damage, personal injury or death suffered by him/her caused to other parties as a result of any act, defect, neglect or omission by him/herself.

Any player may be required to submit to a doping test, which may be carried out any time with no given notice. Failure to submit to the test will be treated as if a positive result has been obtained.

No complaint in connection with the tournament can be entered by the Tournament Committee unless made in writing and lodged with the Tournament Secretary within 48 hours of the occurrence causing the complaint.

The decision of the Tournament Committee in all matters shall be final.
